

# **Mighty Marlins Swim Camp**

## **2010**

### **The Details**

#### **Days 1-3 at Beautiful Flowing Lake County Park**

Somewhat remote lake, with a shallow swimming area, with a rocky bottom. Bring shoes to wear in the water

**Activities to include:** 1 mile trail hike (or run), Volleyball, Swimming

**Directions:** From Hwy 9 go east on Hwy 92, turn right on Machias Rd, left on Ok Mill Rd, right on Carlson, follow as it turns to the right, go straight through a 4 way stop, left on 48<sup>th</sup>. As you enter the park go right and loop around to the left. Drop off just beyond the shelter on the right. Drop off is free, if you plan to park and stay you will need to pay \$5 at the pay station at the entrance of the park.

#### **Day 4 at Sandy Jetty Island** **Note different start and end time**

Beautiful sandy beach area. Jetty Island Ferry will depart for the Island at **11:00**. 40 spots on the ferry have been reserved for camp participants. Return from island has been reserved for **3:45** arriving at parking area at about **4:00**.

**Activities to include:** Wading water exercises, Sand Castle building contest

**Directions:** To Jetty Island Ferry-South out of Marysville on Hwy 529, just across bridge exit, exit curves and goes down hill, at bottom of hill go left onto West Marine View Drive, follow around, right on 10<sup>th</sup>, go to the end of the road and park off to the left.

#### **Day 5 at Awe Inspiring Kayak Point County Park** **With Banquet to Follow at 3:00**

Rocky Puget Sound Beach area, cold water. There will be no swimming this day.

**Activities to include:** Beach running, Stair training, Find a Marlin

**Directions:** From I-5 or Smokey Point Blvd get onto 140<sup>th</sup> St. NW (Fire Trail road) headed west, road veers to the right and becomes Kayak Point road, at intersection with Marine View Drive go straight through into park. Drop off is free, if you plan to park and stay you will need to pay \$5 at the pay station at the entrance of the park. We have the big shelter just at the bottom of the hill reserved for the day. Parking is very limited at the bottom area of the park. There is a loading zone by the shelter.
